Breakdown barriers - be bold

Using the same systems to store and share info

More open and accessible sharing of data - clear purpose and action once data is shared

Enhance transitions with key staff/ people there

Earlier transition meetings

Raise the importance of Transition/ TAC meetings with FE/ HE for CE with schools

Recognising support and approach is more important than system. Staying true to your values and not oversharing to fit the system

More open conversations, knowledge of what systems

Regular, whole sector networking days

CAMHS access to Ayrshare

Multi agency platform for all disciplines to access the same information. Sharing it so nothing is missed from anyone - Scotland/ UK wide

No name consults to start with

Information sharing platform, secure, reliable, safe, empowering

Find all current data sharing agreements and see if they can be expanded to include more agencies

Create bespoke platforms for pan Ayrshire data sharing between relevant services

Passing on each others websites, QR codes to give a wider net of info

Willingness to discuss and consider redesign

Streamlining/ simplification that young people can understand too

Data sharing agreements to support the process of sharing info between orgs. If there is a lawful basis you can share!
