Event Challenges

We need systems that talk to each other in ways to share data meaningfully between sectors to achieve this

Using data meaningfully and including life stories and experiences data

Data sharing/ barriers to sharing data is still an issue in child protection and when a child may pose a risk to others. GDPR is a barrier to keeping children safe.

More data automation for reporting - e.g. have SEEMIS or Carefund automatically generate machine readable formats for Scot Gov reporting

What do we need to record? How do we need to record it? (there's always something missing/ wrong)

Recognising 'small wins' in data gathered - more small wins the better

We have partner agencies who 'hold' info and data and don't share this, impacting on how we can better understand, reflect and work together

Understanding data, fully knowing GDPR and what is safe to share. Information to support young people when necessary

In a small country with a small population of Care exp people there is a tension between data sharing and privacy which I do sometimes get concerned about

Do not lose track of the wee person in there

Better integration needed between digital platforms that record information/ data

Systems that are capable of this. everyone using something different

Asking people 'on the ground' what info/ data they would find helpful to have/ record

Event Solutions

Different agreements in place for different local authorities - eg CEYP Attainment Fund as an example

Full discussion with all stakeholders on what data is collected, what needs to be collected, what should be collected. How can we change a system if we don't know what makes it up

Shared indicators and systems that talk to each other. Consistent implementation of improvement methodology to use data in a better way

Unsure how or where and what for participation data is gathered. It is all there for someone some day
